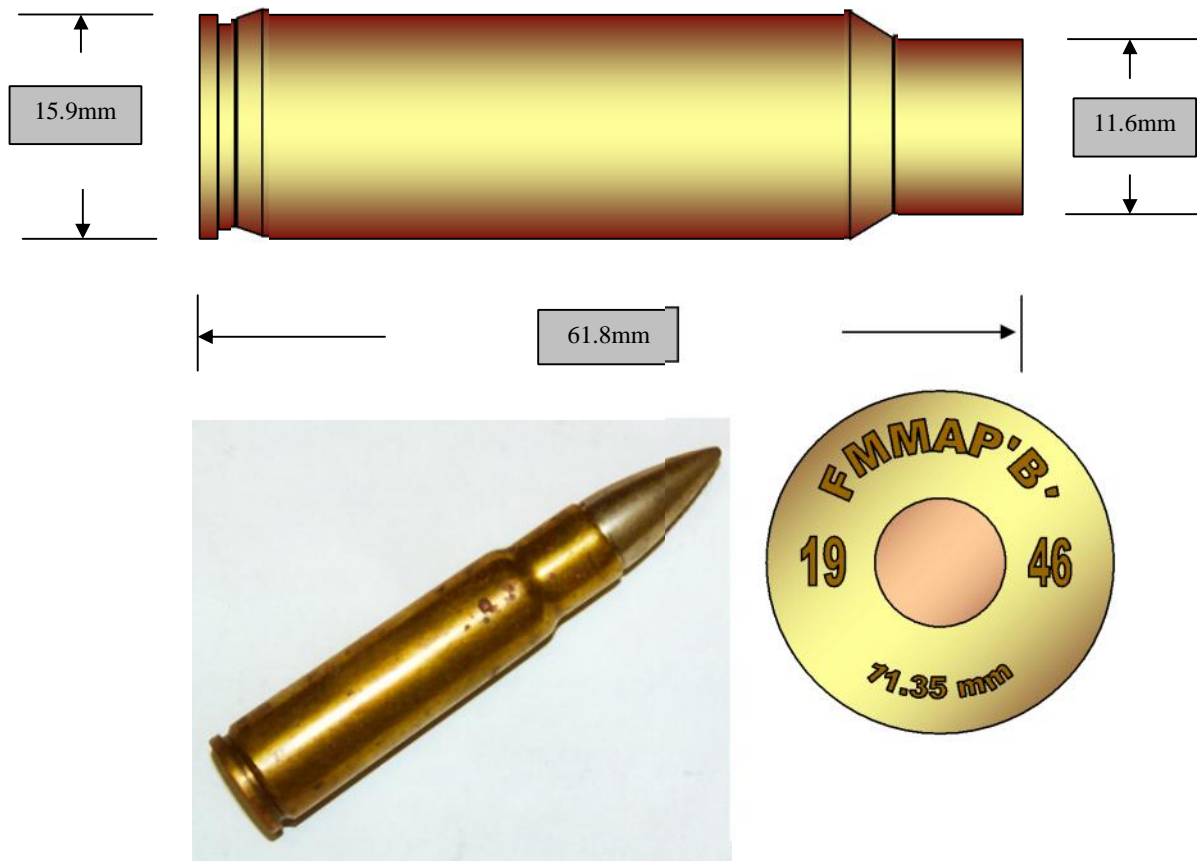


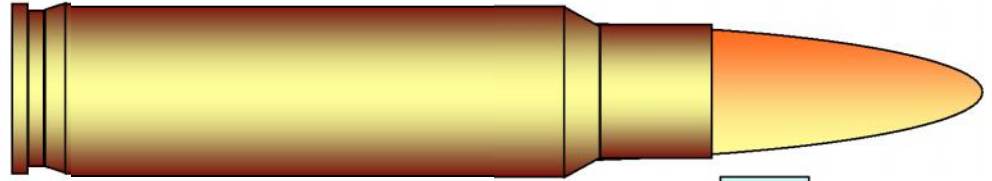
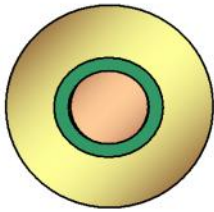
11.35 MADSEN

This cartridge is bit of an oddity in that it was only made by two countries, England and Argentina, and used by only one, Argentina. It was developed in the late 1920s for use in the Madsen ground and aircraft machine guns. The small case capacity ensured that it had a very short service life. Some of the great powers were beginning to look at cannon calibres for air combat at this time, which didn't help the survival of this cartridge.

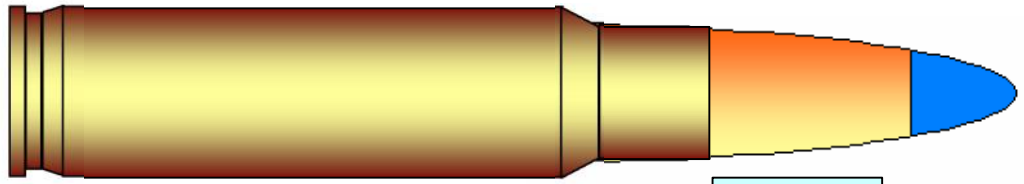
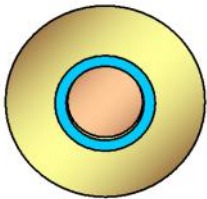
The case was filled with 5.8 gms of NC propellant.



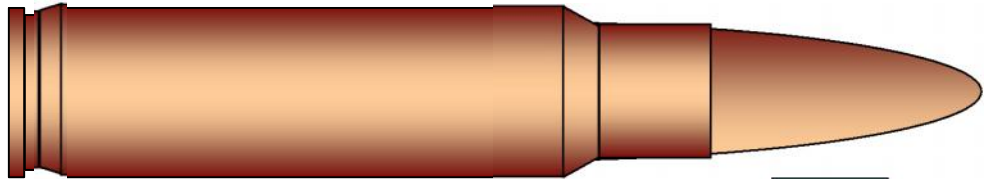
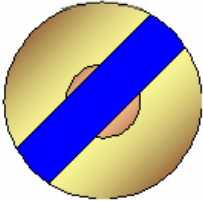
