

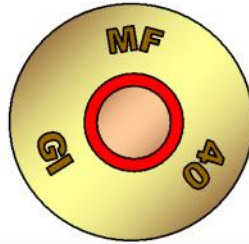
# .303 TRACER CARTRIDGES

Australia made .303 tracers from 1928 to 1945.

Our first tracer was the SPG made in 1928 and then we commenced manufacture of Mk.I in 1928 through to 1941. In all we made four versions of .303 tracers all closely patterned on British models. We ceased making tracers in 1945.

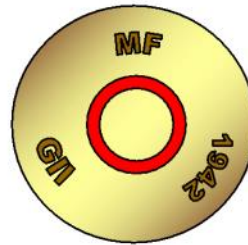


Mk I made at MF in 1940. This model was made from 1928 to 1941

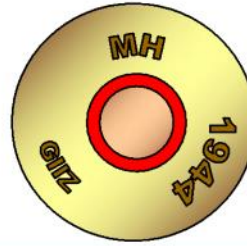

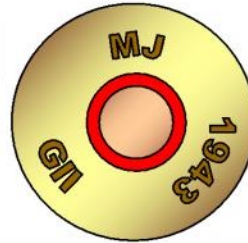

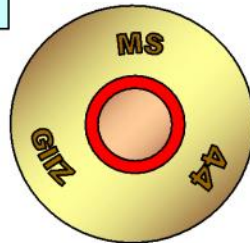
