

## ALDERSHOT GRENADE.

This simulator was a very simple item being nothing more than a cardboard body filled with gunpowder and having a simple match composition to ignite the filling. A protective strip was removed from the match composition and it was quickly drawn over a rough match surface, which ignited the delay column. The delay element burnt through to the filling, which exploded. Being made of cardboard and fairly flimsy at that the explosion was not very convincing, but it did add some degree of realism to the training.

The initial instructions written on the grenade label indicated that it could also be used to simulate artillery shell bursts. Even less convincing that a simulated grenade.
