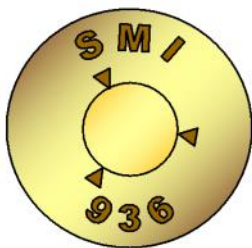


8mm BREDA/FIAT MACHINE GUN

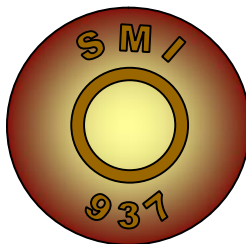
Introduced in 1935 this cartridge was used in the FIAT 35 heavy machine gun that was an upgrade of the 6.5mm FIAT 14. The first BREDA to use this cartridge was the Model 1937.

Second model 8x59 with grooved base and impressed headstamp



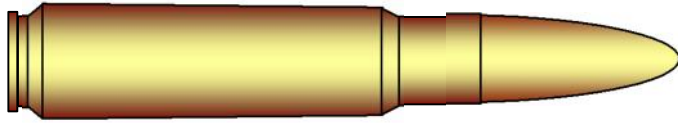
Final model 8x59 with grooved base and embossed headstamp

It is believed that there existed an early dummy M35 possibly headstamped SMI 934-A with a 3mm hole located 46mm from the base, an empty primer pocket, gilding metal jacket on the projectile and the cartridge case was nickered all over.

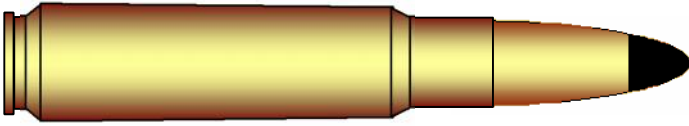
A second dummy had a brass case with a blind primer pocket, a gmcs projectile.

Line thrower cartridge for Naval purposes with standard case closed by a red painted cardboard wad.

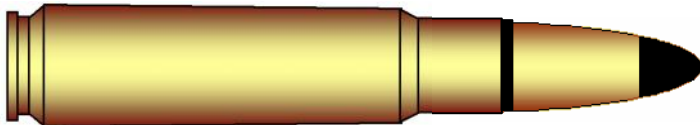
There is possibly a black tipped spotting cartridge.



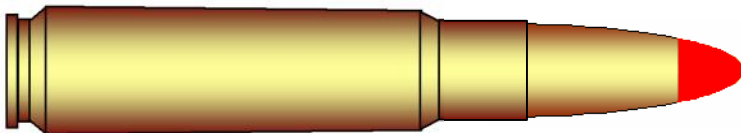
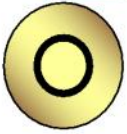
AP model 1929



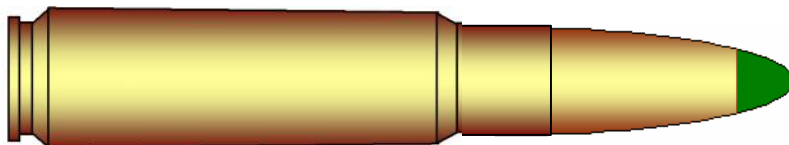
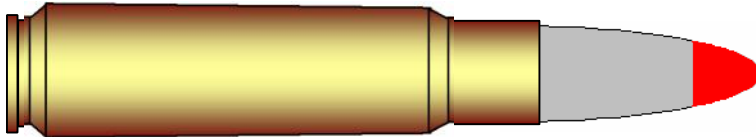
AP model 1949



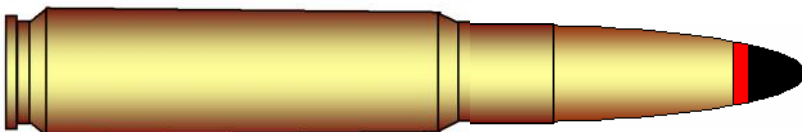
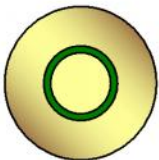
Tracer model 1929
