

GRENADE HAND No. 29

Introduced in September 1917

It was filled with 95cc of SK, KJ, MSK or KSK.

SK = 75% Ethyl Iodoacetate and 25% alcohol

KJ = Stannic chloride

KSK = 100% Ethyl Iodoacetate

MSK = Methylidoacetate.

It had the same ignition system as the No. 28 percussion version.

The Mk II differs from the Mk I in that the detonator holder is made from cast iron instead of mild steel.
