

GRENADE HAND SMOKE No. 79

Naval and RAF chappies aren't very impressed with WP as a material to be carried in their ships and aeroplanes so they asked that a smoke grenade could be made without WP as the filling. This grenade is the result. It was declared obsolete in 1945.

It has a tinned plate body filled with either:

400 grammes of PN 83 (M), (HCE) or,
530 grammes of PN 398 (CTC)

It was fuzed with the No. 247 (Allways)
