

GRENADE RIFLE 2.5 INCH No. 64 DAYLIGHT SIGNAL

This grenade is similar in construction, operation and dimensions to the series 57 to 63. It was a signal grenade employed in the navy for emergency work or exercise work to show an exercise torpedo attack.

It contained two signal stars in lieu of the smoke composition.

It was introduced into service in 1936 and is still current with some naval forces.
