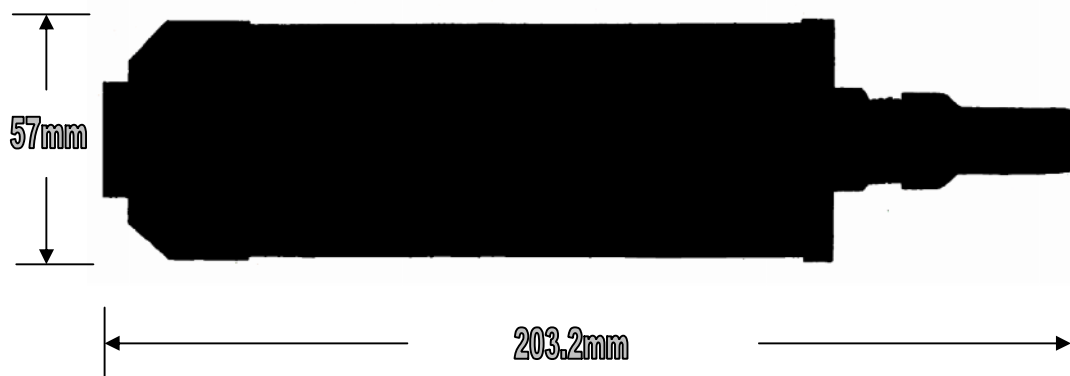
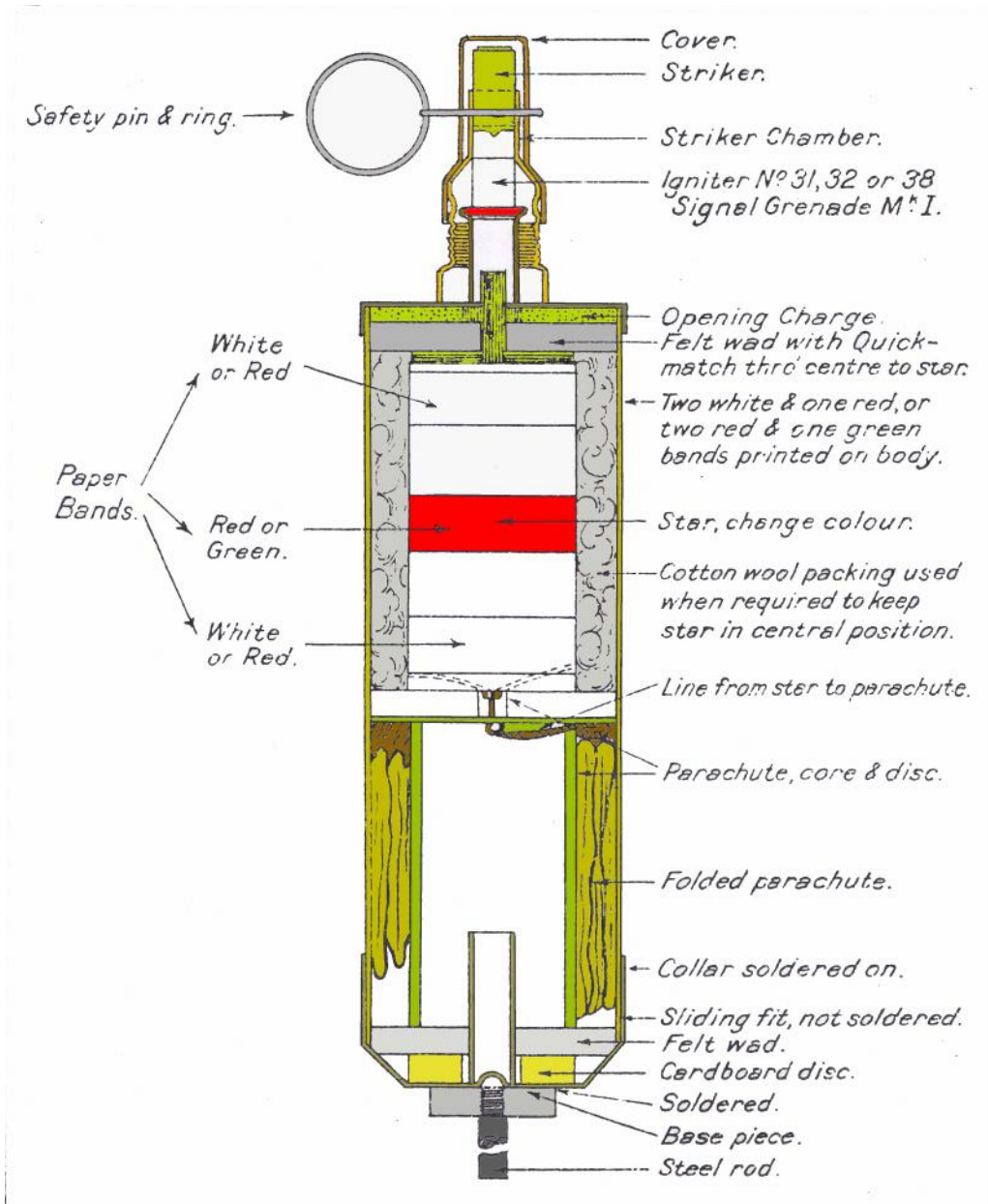


GRENADE RIFLE No. 38

Introduced in September 1918 this rodded grenade was based on the No. 32 Mk II and differs only in that it carries a RED-GREEN-RED, or WHITE-RED-WHITE coloured star sequence and the parachute was protected by a felt cushion.





ACTION.
 Prior to firing the safety pin and the cap are removed. The grenade is then fired from the rifle and this action causes the striker to set back hitting the percussion cap the flash from this is passed to the quickmatch and this ignites the star composition. At the same time the grenade is propelled from the rifle
