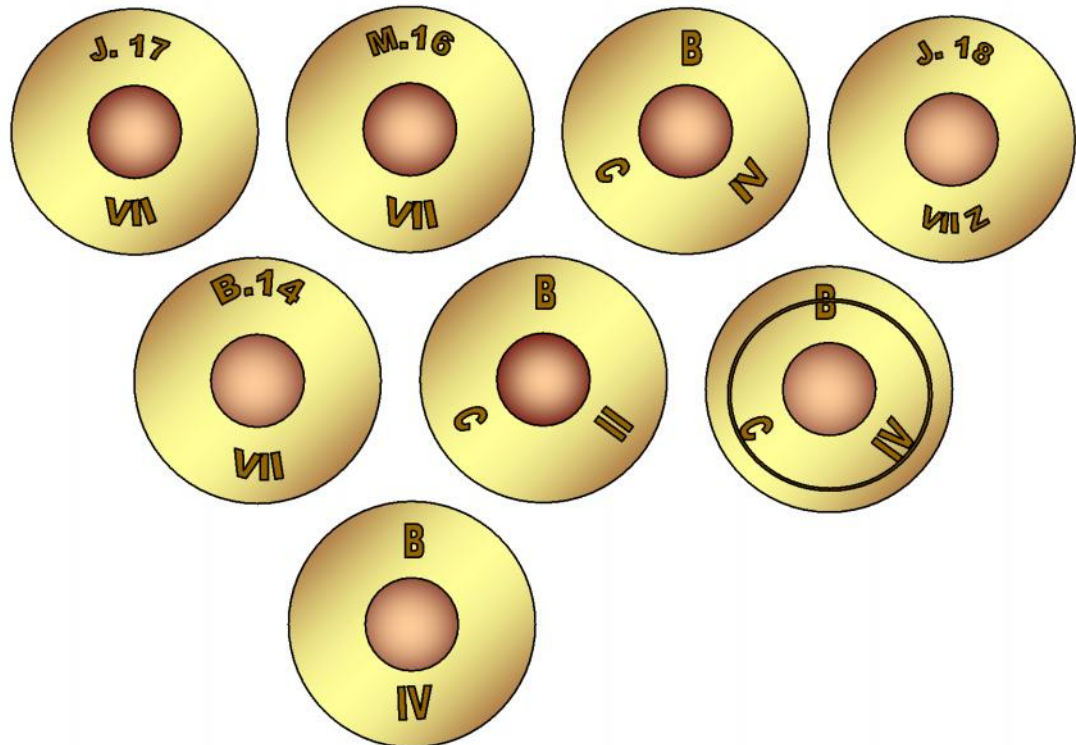


BIRMINGHAM METAL MUNITIONS CO. LTD.

This factory commenced operations in 1897 when Nobels Explosives Coy acquired the rolling mills and ammunition plant of the earlier Birmingham Small Arms and Metal Company at Adderly Park, Birmingham. These companies and further explosives companies were amalgamated into what was later called "Explosives Trades Ltd" and then Nobel industries. Later this became the famous Imperial chemical Industries Ltd.



This company used four different headstamps on .303 ammunition. Viz; B, J, M and N.
Ringed H/S indicates reloaded case I believe.
There are primer variations between domed and flat in these cartridges.

AP ammunition was produced
Explosive PSA Mk 2 (VII. AA)

This company operated the GCF No 1 at Blackheath, Staffordshire
