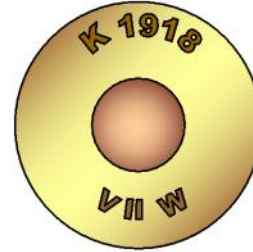
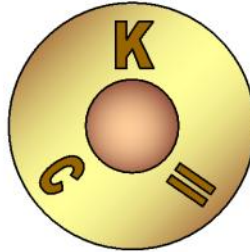
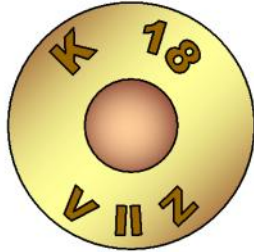


KYNOCH & CO.

This was the original Kynoch Ammunition Company that was first involved in making percussion caps at Witton, Birmingham. This was in 1862. The structure of the company was changed in 1884 and metallic ammunition production commenced. Mr. Kynoch was forced out of the company in 1889 and the name changed to Kynoch Ltd in 1897. The first .303 ammunition was made in 1890 at Witton. Initial H/S was GKB and then K. The company became part of ICI in 1927, but the headstamp retained the K as some sort of tribute to Mr. Kynoch.
