

BELGIAN 9MM BERGMANN-BAYARD

This cartridge was developed from the German 9mm Bergmann No. 6 M1903 semi-auto pistol. It was made under license in Belgium where it was known as the Bergmann-Bayard. It was also adopted by the Danish Army in 1910 and adopted and manufactured in Spain for their service pistol in 1905. It was known as the 9mm Largo in Spain.

It is similar to the No. 6 being slightly shorter in over-all length due to the deeper seating of the projectile.

The projectile weighed 8.8 gms with a MV of 340ms.
