

# 11.3mm GASSER

This cartridge was used in a revolver designed by Leopold Gasser and adopted by the Austro-Hungarian army in 1870. Dimensionally it is the same as the Austro-Hungarian M1867 Carbine. The difference between the two is in the base. The Carbine load being heavier is provided with a Mauser "A" base and the revolver cartridge has a flat base. These weapons were purchased by Montenegro and the cartridge became known as the "Montenegrin".
