

THE DOMINION OF CANADA RIFLE ASSOCIATION BANDED MATCH CARTRIDGES

In 1921 the Canadian Rifle Association moved to a new rifle range and to commemorate the event they initiated a shooting match with specially prepared ammunition. This ammunition was marked with coloured bands to indicate its match status. The colour and number of bands was as follows:
