

TIME No. 400

This fuze is similar to the Time No. 198, which was introduced in 1925 as a time fuze for naval star shells. The screw thread on the outside of the fuze body is to fit a hermetically sealed cover to protect the hygroscopic time rings.

The difference between the 198 and the 400 is that the 400 has a different time ring composition.
