

TIME & PERCUSSION No. 81

Fuze time & percussion No. 81 was introduced for naval service in 1909. It is a modified version of the No. 80, which was all aluminium. The marine environment corroded the time rings preventing their adjustment. This fuze was produced to overcome this problem. The body is made of gunmetal. There were two marks of this fuze and it was declared obsolete in 1945.

It was used in star shell 6 inch & 12 pr. It is similar to the No. 93 Mk 1
The time rings are filled "30 second powder".
